I'm writing to you today to request that you honor the wishes of the more than 1,000 registered Wyckoff voters who have signed the petitions urging you to place two public questions on the November ballot.

Some citizens of Wyckoff feel that our town needs regulation to protect our trees and preserve our suburban charm. Other citizens feel that regulations are not required.

I personally feel that enough voters have expressed interest in these matters that, if I were in your position, I would want to take an accurate, unbiased reading on the pulse of the voters and allow the non-binding questions to be placed on the ballot. Only after the votes had been counted would I feel that I had sufficient information that would allow me to act in the best interests of my constituents.

Please, place these two questions on the November ballot and let democracy run it's course!
