However, the questions will allow us the chance to "raise a hand" showing we are concerned, like them, about open space and trees, here, in Wyckoff. When they see, by a count, that the concern is shared they can proceed with confidence that they are acting with the township beside them. But they must act NOW! Paperwork must be filed soon for the questions to appear this November. And they are the only ones who can file.

The Township Committee cares about Wyckoff and their record shows they are great public servants. We are counting on them to have these non-binding referendums on the ballot in November.
